EHF European Women's Handball Championship

Germany, the World Championship runner-up, is dreaming of the title

- Alongside defending champions Norway, as well as Denmark and Hungary, **Germany** is one of only four teams to have **taken part in all 16 finals** of the EHF European Women's Handball Championship.
- **Last year, the DHB women's team won the silver medal at the World Championship**, which was co-hosted with the Netherlands.
- At this year's continental championships, which are being held in Romania, the Czech Republic, Slovakia and Turkey, **the German team has its sights set on the title**.
- **Das Erste and ZDF will be broadcasting** the German national team's **matches** at this tournament **live** on their main channels.

Facts and Figures I

- **What is the competition format?**

24 teams take part in the European Championship. They play a preliminary round in six groups of four teams each. The top two teams from each group in the preliminary round advance to the main round. This consists of two groups, each with six teams. Here, each team plays four additional matches. At the end of the main round, the top two teams from each group qualify for the semi-finals and have the chance to reach the final or the third-place play-off.

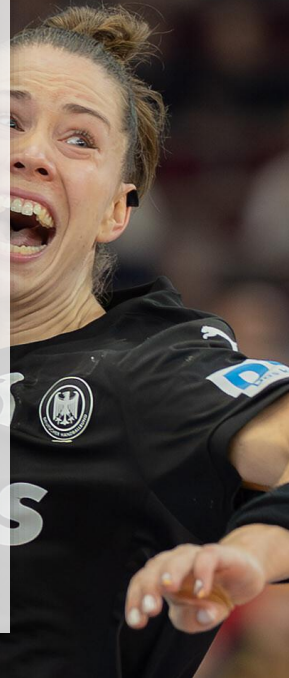
- **When does Germany play and who will broadcast?**

Germany will face the following opponents in Group F of the group stage:

Fri 4 Dec 26, at 6:00 p.m. – **Sweden**, live on ZDF

Sun 6 Dec 26, at 6:00 p.m. – **Serbia**, live on Das Erste (ad-free)

Tue 8 Dec 26 at 6:00 p.m. – **Slovakia**, live on Das Erste

Facts and Figures II

- **What happens next in the main round?**

It is expected that Germany will qualify for the main round and play at least **four** additional matches. **Two** of these would be broadcast by **ZDF** and two by Das Erste. The dates have been confirmed, but the throw-off times and broadcast allocations will only be announced once the preliminary round has concluded on **Wed 9 Dec 26**.

Main round dates:

Fri 11 Dec, Sun 13 Dec, Tue 15 Dec and Wed 16 Dec 26 (3:30 p.m., 6:00 p.m. or 8:30 p.m.)

Assuming the tournament proceeds as normal, it is likely that **two DHB matches in the main round** could be **advertising-relevant on ZDF**. Both would have a decisive influence on the further course of the tournament. Advertising rates can be found in the charts below.

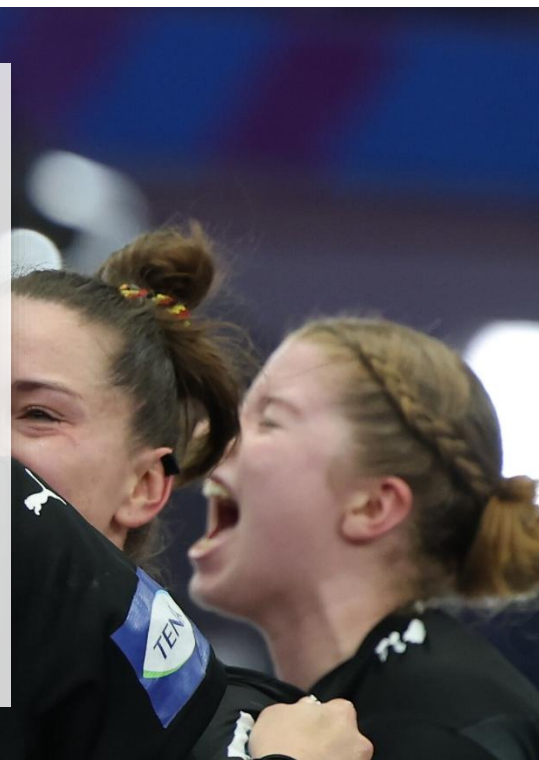
